#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING OUT:**

Enroll in STEP: - Smart Traveler Enrollment Program ~ A free service that allows US citizens and nationals to receive

important information or be notified about safety conditions in your destination country by the embassy, helping you make informed decisions about your travel plans. Also Helps the U.S. Embassy contact you in an emergency, whether natural disaster, civil unrest, or family emergency (think earthquake, terrorist bombing or train derailment type thing). Check each country for updated embassy alerts and warnings.

PASSPORT: Number and Expiration Date: Jot down the number to use for transportation reservations. Some site

tickets and some lodging reservations require your number depending on the country. The expiration date of your passport is **very important**. Passports should have at least six months of validity when traveling internationally from the <u>final day</u> of travel. Most countries will not permit a traveler to enter their country if their **passport** is set to **expire within this time frame, they may deny you entry!** Certain countries also require proof of departure such as an airline reservation. Additionally, many countries require an empty page or two for your stamp. Check each country you visit on the International Travel

Page at www.travel.state.gov.

**TRAVEL INSURANCE:** Although not required, travel insurance is an inexpensive peace of mind when traveling outside your

country of origin. Many countries will not treat you without some sort of insurance or CASH. In addition,

depending on the policy, travel insurance covers many other kinds of events

MEDS: Document what medications you need and check to see if they are allowed in the countries you visit

(some are not). Make sure you have prescriptions with you if needed and phone numbers related.

CREDIT CARDS: Research if yours is widely accepted, (VISA AND MASTERCARD are most common) and research your

affiliate ATMs and International fees.

**DOCS SCANNED:** Scan all documents and email to yourself, send to the cloud or send a copy to a friend just in case you

need them. Documents include: passport, drivers licenses, insurance cards, credit cards (front and back),

train, site passes or whatever you may need.

COUNTRIES: List all

**EMBASSY LOCATION:** Write down City and Address in case you need help in that country.

<u>VISA:</u> IS A Visa Required? Are there costs and deadlines? Document website and application references.

**VACCINES:** Research if any vaccines are need for entry and when you need them/ documentation. A more common

vaccine required is Yellow Fever. Some countries only require it when coming from a country with an

outbreak. Be prepared!

TRAVEL ADVISORIES: Research what advisories are listed for safety! There are 4 categories
